Dear Parents/Guardians,

As-Salaamu 'alaikum wa Rahmatullaahi wa Barakaatuh

School Fees 2024/2025

I pray that this letter reaches you in the best of health and the highest state of Imaan.

I am writing to inform you about the increase of school fees for the academic year 2024/2025. Parents are aware that our school's provision is distinguished by the elaborate programme for Aalimah/Hifz/Islamic Studies, which requires an entire team of professional staff and dedicated resources expenditure.

At AAGS we strive to ensure the provision of quality education and a nurturing environment that promotes the holistic development of each student. As part of our continuous efforts to maintain and improve standards of education, the fee increase is due to the growing demands of the changing educational landscape. The increase in minimum wage by almost 10%, effective from 2024, places additional financial strain on the school, as it impacts the salaries of 78 staff employed at the girl's school.

The school committee is always very sensitive to the impact on families when any fee increase incurs, however it is now necessary to increase fees to enable the school to continue to provide a high-quality, well-resourced educational provision for all students in our care. The school relies solely on the school fees for the operating costs of the school. However, annually the school continues to run at a deficit which means that school fees do not cover all the cost of running the school.

After conducting an intensive fee review, we have made the decision to increase school fees for academic year 2024/2025 to £3900. School fees will be further reviewed in 2025.

Re-registration fees will remain at £100 per annum which is payable in May/June of each year.
